This month we focused on using the review topic of animals to learn can and can't, we practiced movement words and sang songs about animals.

We played games about animals and the movements they make, the sounds they make, and the places they live. For example, if the animal lives in the sky then it flies or if the animal lives on the ground then it walks.

We started learning can and can't to describe animals. *The bird can fly. It can't swim. It can run. It can't jump.* Movement words that we were introduced to: run, walk, jump, fly, crawl, and swim.

We also read a book together called, Old MacDonald's Funny Farm, which is a variation on the classic story. The animals on the "funny farm" were a shark, penguin, sloth, tarantula, moose, and elephant! We read the story together, sang the song, and practiced those animals' movements and sounds.
