This month we started our second Itty Bitty Phonics Reader book. Each student is given the same book for their class. We use the words to practice pronunciation and the particular phonics sound that is focused on in the book.

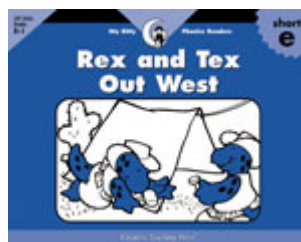
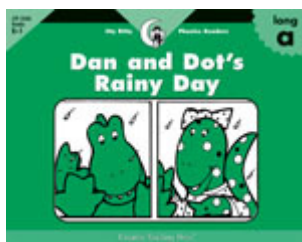
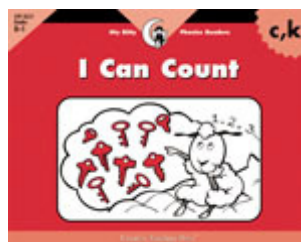
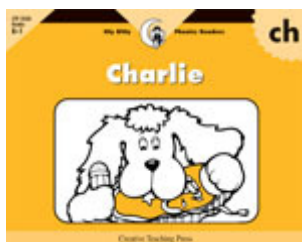
Each student repeats the words after the teacher and then we look at the pictures to understand the meaning. Then we use the pictures for a listening and coloring exercise.

As said before, the phonics readers are grouped into 4 types: long vowels, short vowels, consonants and consonant blends. The hazırlık classes are working on the consonant sounds and the yuva on the vowel sounds.

This month the Çiçek class worked with "ch" sounds, like chair, chalk, and cheek. The story is about a dog named Charlie and the things he does.

Arı class worked with the sounds "c and k", in the book I Can Count. For example: key, cat, kitten, kite, and count.

The yuva classes continued with vowel sounds again. Kelebek class is reading Rex and Tex Out West that practices the "short e" sound. And Uğur Böceği class is reading Dan and Dot's Rainy Day which practices the "long a" sound.
